I. Jennifer called the meeting to order at 10:11 a.m.

II. Maria moved to approve the agenda. Second by Paul. Motion passed.

## III. Presenters:

- a. SPPS Tribal Consultation:
  - Documents requested for the consultations were emailed from Carita Green on June 1, 2023 including the 21st Century CCLC Grant plan.
  - Superintendent, School Board Chair/Vice-Chair, AIPAC and other staff were present.
  - 1,078 (Al student count as of October 1, 2022.)
  - Using state identification in counting Al students.
  - Grad rate improved (relies on MDE for some data) from 59% to 62%.
  - Tracking progress of students.
  - Intervention is assigned to connect with schools in tracking students. There is one staff member dedicated specifically to this.
  - Reading class at AIMs (literacy skills).
  - Flipside Program: there is an increased number of students. More information will be provided at the October meeting.
  - Check & Connect Program doesn't work for SPPS.
  - IE program could use additional 2-3 FTE for staffing.
  - 21<sup>st</sup> Century Grant Cohort 9 application needs affirmation form signed by June 29, 2023 (?)
- b. Dan Torrez, MDE (Special Education Division) Alternative & Preventative Services Specialist and Govinda Budrow, Project Consultant:
  - Power Point (PP) shared (Dan will provide/send copy to TNEC).
  - Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) update.
  - PBIS is in statute.
  - There is an Al work group names included in PP.

- There is a PBIS Cultural Guide (see PP).
- Are there any Al staff? Unsure.
- Meets with OIE consistently.
- c. Tyler Livingston, MDE Educator Workforce Programs Supervisor:
  - ➤ MN Indian Teacher Training Program (MITTP) update:
  - Power Point shared.
  - Two new things: Funding stays (unused funds do not go back) offered grants are now for 5-year periods.
  - 4 grantees named in statute 3 of the 4 have applied (the 4<sup>th</sup> Bemidji is ready to apply.)
  - Tyler will send (grant apps) pdf to TNEC for review. **Review and comment by June 30**<sup>th</sup> (?)
  - Competitive grants there have been 3.
  - With additional/new MITTP funds consider increasing the number of grantees or increase the 92,000-funding cap?
  - Include MITTP on July meeting agenda.
  - Email any questions to Tyler and he will prepare answers and have them ready for the July TNEC meeting.
- d. Maria Asp, Director of Community Outreach & Education (*Reconsidering MN History Project*) and Tessa Flynn Henerson, Director of Programming. Organization representing: Speaking Out Collective.
  - Would like to share about the Reconsidering MN History project.
  - Have been testing the stories with pre-K 6<sup>th</sup> grade.
  - Will send links and videos/curriculum.
  - Would like TNEC feedback.
- e. Opalina Peralta for Shannon Geshick, MIAC Executive Director:
  - ➤ MIAC update:
  - There is a small increase for language funding.
  - RFP will be coming out soon.
  - Next MIAC meeting is August 16-18 at PIIC.
  - Would like the TNEC report 2 weeks prior to the meeting.
- f. Anjanette Parisien & Sam Zimmerman, MDE OIE Indigenous Specialists:
  - Summary report May 18 June 22, 2023 discussed.
  - JPA: Bois Forte & White Earth are done. Grand Portage and Prairie Island are sending invoices.
  - Website updated.
  - The Commissioner gave crunch deadlines for questions and surveys.
  - AIEFA will be updated at the July retreat at MDE.

- g. Leigh Nida and Dawn Cameron, MDE Division of Academic Standards, Instruction, and Assessment:
  - There are 3 upcoming working groups established by legislation (Computer Science, Ethnic Studies and Holocaust & Genocide of Indigenous) and TNEC representation is requested on these working groups. It would be a similar application process of standards review.
  - In the past it was determined that there would be 4 seats on standards committees reserved for TNEC members.
  - TNEC will again request volunteers from committee to volunteer and serve (and will get the names to Leigh and/or Dawn by September.)
  - Note: Volunteers for these three committees will be added to the July TNEC meeting agenda.
  - ➤ Dawn: Test development teams requesting TNEC involvement.
  - There will be 45-60 meetings scheduled for mid-June through mid-August.
  - Test development for standards that align to benchmarks.
  - Are there any questions about Al contributions now? Yes. How many? Do not have this information.
  - Dawn will send meeting dates.
  - Meetings are virtual.
  - There is compensation. \$160 per day.

- Tribal data sharing:
- In the past agreements were created for those wanting access.
- Now districts should share data with Federally recognized tribes regarding their students.
- OIE can nudge districts with the statute.
- TNEC questions for all MDE departments as at the July retreat: (1) How do you support Al students? (2) How do you support OIE?
- Other info shared:
- Working on Al guidance document.
- Working on how does OIE support parent committees in the best way possible.
- Carryover of funs are now in statute can carryover up to 50% of what is not spent with PC, OIE in agreement and if the PC voted in

- concurrence and the district shows sufficient reason why (and spent before December?)
- The end of the fiscal year is June 30<sup>th</sup>.
- At least one hour of school program must have observance to Indigenous Peoples Day.
- 172 districts will receive Al Education Aid.
- Superintendent's meeting is scheduled for August 8, 2023 at Marriott. TNEC members who plan to attend: Jackie, Jennifer and Beth.
- Nothing in legislation regarding smudging students can carry loose tobacco/medicine pouch.
- i. Lisa Clemens, Data Manager Midwest Indigenous Immersion Network.
  - Provides support and assistance to immersion schools.
  - 2023 survey conducted regarding students receiving language instruction (copy of survey was emailed.)
  - Response rate for the survey was 97% in Minnesota and 92% in Wisconsin.
  - Want to recruit students who want to teach and find jobs after college.
  - 2024 there will be a test track if they're in immersion education.
  - Focus: (1) locate students, (2) find program and once graduated, (3) find positions.
  - Data will be presented to tribes, MDE and the public.

  - Is invited and is willing to come and share updates with TNEC.
